Instructions for BOLIM Feast of Tabernacles at the BOLIM Discipleship Training Center (DTC):

- 1) Remember that you will be lodging with others so please keep personal items organized and shared areas clean.
- 2) You will have access to the restrooms to wash your face and brush your teeth on Saturday morning.
- 3) Keep in mind that we will be in mixed company (men, women, and children) so **appropriate dress is always mandatory.**
- 4) You are welcome to bring snacks for you and your family, but they are to be kept in your area and the wrappings discarded and the remaining snacks taken home after Tabernacles avoid attracting ants, etc.
- 5) Please remember that this is a Ministry gathering and our purpose is to spend time with Yahweh and with one another as a family. We ask that everyone respect the gathering by avoiding phone use or other distractions during the times of ministry and fellowship.
- 6) Remember that we are expected to be faithful stewards of our very own BOLIM DTC. Any damages due to negligence or accident by anyone in the BOLIM Family will be repaired or replaced by the person//persons who damaged the property.
- 7) Please honor the instructions given when you arrive at the BOLIM Feast of Tabernacles Gathering. For example, the kitchen is a restricted area only for those who will serve on the Kitchen Service Team. This is for all of our protection and sanitation safety.
- 8) This is a family gathering and we want to always protect our children. We ask that parents know where their children are at all times! At no time will minors (anyone under 18 years old) be allowed to go anywhere without adult supervision. Let's work together to protect the children and youth of our Congregation!
- 9) Disrespectful and/or Unruly behavior will NOT be tolerated at the BOLIM Feast of Tabernacles Gathering. Attendees will be asked to leave immediately for any behavior that is considered to be disruptive or out of order.
- 10) If you or your child have any symptoms of illness [including but not limited to fever >100 F, vomiting, conjunctivitis (pink eye), rashes, pediculosis (head lice)], please stay home and join us online for Sabbath Worship on Saturday @ 4 pm CST.
