What a powerful and impactful time we've had in Discipleship Training thus far! We begin Salvation – Part 2 today as part of the first track. Raise your expectations and let's go higher and deeper in YAH!

**TAKE NOTE:**

The start of the journey of reconciliation and relationship with Yahweh comes through a Blood Covenant that is initiated by Yahweh. We know it as Atonement. Let's explore this in the scripture and discuss it: (Genesis 3:20, Leviticus 16, Leviticus 23:26-31, Hebrews 9:11-15).

Now that we have studied the root word of Salvation (Save/Saved), we will now proceed with studying the word "Salvation".

**Salvation in HEBREW**

**Strong's H3444 - yǎšû'â**  
**Pronunciation** yesh-oo'-aw

- 1) salvation, deliverance
  - a) welfare, prosperity
  - b) deliverance
  - c) salvation (by God)
  - d) victory

**Salvation**

The word "Salvation" (in the KJV) is first mentioned in **Genesis (BERĔSHITH) 49:18:**  
18 I have waited for your **deliverance**, O יהוה!"

Yes, You are seeing this correctly – **SALVATION** IN HEBREW IS INDEED YESHUA as Our Savior's Name means "YAHWEH IS SALVATION" PRAISE YAHWEH FOREVER!

And yes, the Name of our Savior Yeshua is appropriately introduced in the first book of the Bible (Genesis/BERESHITH/in the beginning)!

**"Salvation/Deliverance" in the Scriptures (TS2009)**

**Exodus (SHEMOTH) 14:13** And Mosheh said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the **deliverance** of יהוה, which He does for you today. For the Mitsrites whom you see today, you are never, never to see again.

**Exodus (SHEMOTH) 15:2** Yah is my strength and song, and He has become my **deliverance**. He is my Ĕl, and I praise Him – Elohim of my father, and I exalt Him.

**I Chronicles (DIBRE HAYAMIM ALEPH) 16:23** Sing to יהוה, all the earth; Proclaim His **deliverance** from day to day.

**II Chronicles (DIBRE HAYAMIM BET) 20:17** It is not for you to fight in this. Position yourselves, stand still and see the **deliverance** of יהוה with you, O Yehudah and Yerushalayim!’ Do not be afraid nor fear, go out against them tomorrow, for יהוה is with you.”

**Psalms (TEHILLIM) 3:8** **Deliverance** belongs to יהוה. Your blessing is on Your people. Selah.

**Psalms (TEHILLIM) 62:2, 6** 2 He alone is my rock and my deliverance, my strong tower; I am not greatly shaken. 6 He alone is my rock and my **deliverance**, my strong tower; I am not shaken.

**Psalms (TEHILLIM) 98:2-3** 2 יהוה has made known His **deliverance**; His righteousness He has openly shown Before the eyes of the nations. 3 He has remembered His loving-commitment And His trustworthiness to the house of Yisra’el; All the ends of the earth have seen The **deliverance** of our Elohim.

**Psalms (TEHILLIM) 118:14-15, 21** 14 Yah is my strength and song, And He has become my **deliverance**. 15 The voice of rejoicing and **deliverance** Is in the tents of the righteous; The right hand of יהוה is doing mightily. 21 I thank You, For You have answered me, And have become my **deliverance**.

**Psalms (TEHILLIM) 119:155, 166, 174** 155 **Deliverance** is far from the wrong ones, For they have not sought Your laws. 166 יהוה, I have waited for Your **deliverance**. And I have done Your commands. 174 I have longed for Your **deliverance**, O יהוה, And Your Torah is my delight.

**Isaiah (YESHAYAH) 12:2-3** 2 “See, El is my **deliverance**, I trust and am not afraid. For Yah, יהוה, is my strength and my song; and He has become my **deliverance**.” 3 And you shall draw water with joy from the fountains of **deliverance**.

**Isaiah (YESHAYAH) 26:1** In that day this song is sung in the land of Yehudah, “We have a strong city – He sets up **deliverance**, walls and ramparts.

**Isaiah (YESHAYAH) 52:7, 10** 7 How pleasant upon the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who proclaims peace, who brings good news, who proclaims **deliverance**, who says to Tsiyon, “Your Elohim reigns!” 10 יהוה shall lay bare His set-apart arm in the eyes of all the nations. And all the ends of the earth shall see the deliverance of our Elohim.

**Isaiah (YESHAYAH) 62:1** For Tsiyon’s sake I am not silent, and for Yerushalayim’s sake I do not rest, until her righteousness goes forth as brightness, and her **deliverance** as a lamp that burns.

**Jonah (YONAH) 2:9** But I slaughter to You with the voice of thanksgiving, I pay what I have vowed. **Deliverance** is of יהוה.”

**Salvation in GREEK**  
Strong's G4991 – sōtēria  
Pronunciation so-tay-ree'-ah

- 1) deliverance, preservation, safety, salvation
  - a) deliverance from the molestation of enemies
  - b) in an ethical sense, that which concludes to the soul's safety or salvation
    - i) of Messianic salvation
- 2) salvation as the present possession of all true Believers
- 3) future salvation, the sum of benefits and blessings which the Believers, redeemed from all earthly ills, will enjoy after the visible return of Yeshua Ha’Mashiach from heaven in the consummated and eternal kingdom of God.

**Luke (LUQAS) 1:68-69** 68“Blessed be יהוה Elohim of Yisra’el, for He did look upon and worked redemption for His people, 69 and has raised up a horn of **deliverance** for us in the house of His servant Dawid,

**Luke (LUQAS) 2:29-30** 29 “Now let Your servant go in peace, O Master, according to Your word, 30 for my eyes have seen Your **deliverance**,

**Luke (LUQAS) 19:9** And יהושע said to him, “Today **deliverance** has come to this house – since he also is a son of Abraham.

**John (YOHANAN) 4:22** You worship what you do not know. We worship what we know, because the **deliverance** is of the Yehudim.

**Acts (Ma’asei) 13:47** For so the Master has commanded us, ‘I have set you to be a light to the nations, that you should be for **deliverance** to the ends of the earth.’ Reference: **Isaiah (YESHAYAH) 49:6:** and He says, “Shall it be a small matter for You to be My Servant to raise up the tribes of Ya’aqob, and to bring back the preserved ones of Yisra’el? And I shall give You as a light to the nations, to be My **deliverance** to the ends of the earth!”

**Romans (ROMIYIM) 13:11** And do this, knowing the time, that it is already the hour for us to wake up from sleep, for now our **deliverance** is nearer than when we did believe.

**Hebrews (Ib’rim) 1:14** Are they not all serving spirits sent out to attend those who are about to inherit **deliverance**?

**Hebrews (Ib’rim) 2:10** For it was fitting for Him, because of whom all are and through whom all are, in bringing many sons to esteem, to make the Prince of their **deliverance** perfect through sufferings.

**Hebrews (Ib’rim) 5:9** And having been perfected, He became the Causer of everlasting **deliverance** to all those obeying Him,

**Revelation (Hazon) 19:1** And after this I heard a loud voice of a great crowd in the heaven, saying, “Halleluyah! **Deliverance** and esteem and respect and power to יהוה our Elohim!
