

Why Discipleship?

- Discipleship draws the Believer closer to YAHWEH / YeHoVaH (Ps. 145:17-20, James 4:7-8)
- Discipleship enables Personal and Corporate Preparation to Mobilize Kingdom Purpose (Mt. 28:18-20, Mark 6:7-11)
- Discipleship builds Kingdom CommUNITY (Psalm 133:1-3, Acts 4:31-33)

What this means concerning the format of Sabbath Worship and Breath Of Life Discipleship (BOLD):

- Both Sabbath Worship and BOLD will now be organized in classroom settings and the teachings will be organized by Tracks. Wednesdays will continue to be facilitated via Zoom.
- Every course will be organized so that the teachings will be in order so that, for example, if part 1 begins on Sabbath, then part 2 would be taught the following Wednesday, and so on.
- We will also have time during the training for application and hands-on experience. And we will also offer additional opportunities to hone/sharpen your skills and/or take deeper dives into the principles taught.
- In the beginning, we will have only one track, but eventually, we will offer multiple tracks facilitating various training courses in parallel.
- **The first course is entitled: The Biblical Basis for Salvation, Deliverance, Indwelling of Holy Spirit, and Water Immersion**

A Friendly Reminder of BOLIM Sanctuary and Building Protocols

In the Scripture, there are instructions about how we are to conduct ourselves in the House of Yahweh. In Honor of what Yahweh desires in His House, we operate in Order and have set forth some instructions about the protocols that should be followed in His Sanctuary to bring and keep order.

- No food or drinks are allowed in the sanctuary. Because of the change in the format of the Sabbath Worship Service, bottled water only will be allowed. Chewing gum and candy is not allowed in the sanctuary.
- Using Mobile phones in the sanctuary is prohibited for any use (texting, gaming, talking, social media, etc.). Remember that this can be a distraction for yourself and others and dishonors what Yahweh is doing because your focus is elsewhere. Electronic devices are permitted for accessing Bibles and taking notes. Please ensure that the ringers or other notifications are set to silent.
- The BOLIM DTC is not designed as a charging station for the Congregation's phones and other portable electronics. Unauthorized use is not only disrespectful in the House of Yahweh but it also opens doors to liabilities including but not limited to tripping hazards.
- Please refrain from excessive talking and walking during services; talking out of turn is strictly prohibited.
- Please bear in mind that we are video recording the services so excessive walking, talking, and other distractive behaviors will render the recording unprofessional and possibly unusable.
- Running and playing in the BOLIM DTC is prohibited and strictly prohibited in the Sanctuary.
- Parents or Authorized Guardians are required to accompany children 11 years and younger to the restroom. Children of all ages are prohibited from wandering around the DTC and are never to be left unattended while on the premises (indoors or outdoors).
- Children should always be with their parents in the sanctuary unless otherwise instructed. If a child is making noise including crying, we ask that the parent(s) take the child(ren) to the lobby or restroom to resolve any issue(s).
- If you or any of your family members currently are overcoming a challenge of a contagious infirmity or illness, please worship with us virtually to avoid contact with others until cleared by your physician. Children with visible symptoms will not be allowed into Children of Life. This instruction applies to weekly services as well as any other BOLIM gatherings. We appreciate your cooperation as we do our part to use wisdom in protecting the BOLIM Congregation.
- Please honor the instructions via signs at the BOLIM DTC as well as the instruction of the Facilities, Helps Ministry, and all other Ministry Leaders at all times as they have been given authority to correct any restricted behavior in the BOLIM DTC to protect the Congregation and BOLIM at large. If you have any issues, please see any of the BOLIM Leadership Team and it will be escalated to the Pastors as necessary.
- Please be sober, watchful, vigilant, and prayerful at all times for everyone's protection.
